Sec. 18.1. State Law Adopted.

All of the provisions and requirements of the general law of the state relative to alcoholic beverages, beer and wine, as contained in S.C. Code 1997, § 61-4-10 et seq., are hereby adopted and made a part of this chapter to the same extent as if set out at length in this chapter, insofar as such provisions can have application within the Town. It shall be unlawful for any person to violate any provision of such state law within the Town.

Sec. 18.2. Enforcement of Chapter.

Designated and legal or deputized law enforcement officers are hereby authorized, empowered and directed to enforce the provisions of this chapter.

Sec. 18.3 Open Containers.

(a) It shall be unlawful within the corporate limits of the Town for any person to have in his possession an open container of any alcoholic beverage except within the confines of an enclosed building.

(b) This section shall not apply to a private residence and the yard surrounding it.

Any person violating the provisions of this section shall, upon conviction, be punished in accordance with section 14.5 of this Code.
